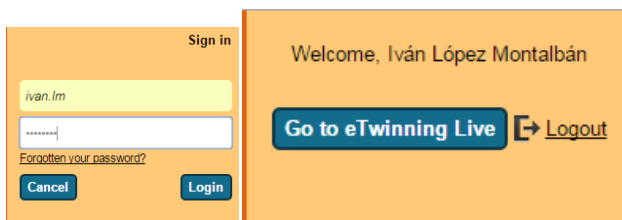


HOW TO ADD YOUR STUDENTS TO THE TWIN SPACE:

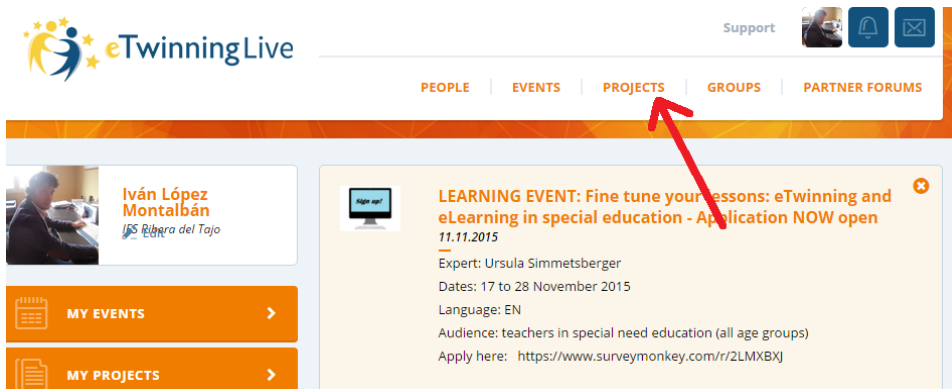
First: Go to <http://www.etwinning.net> and click on "Sign in" (You should have a etwinning account)



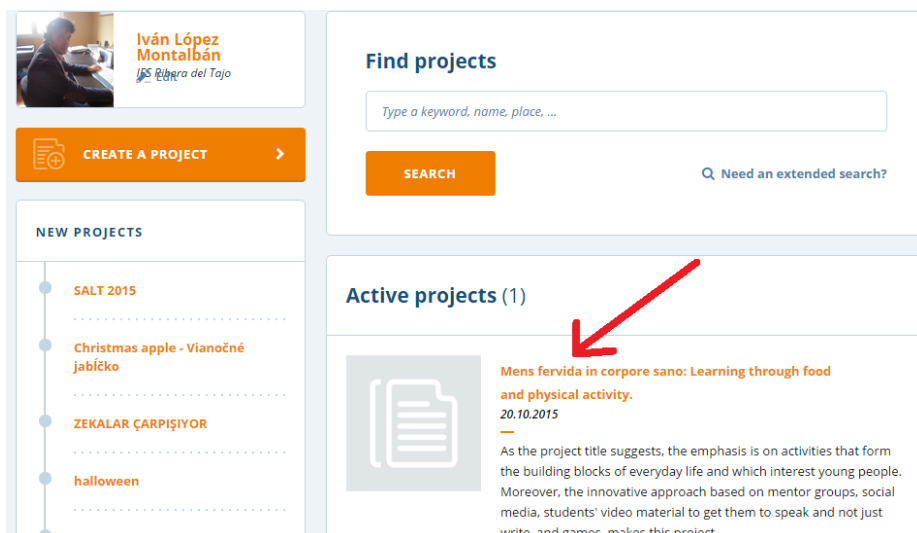
Then, login and go to eTwinning Live:
